ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY/BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH	Guisseppe Errico (1881-1950) was born in Salerno, Italy to Francesco (1857 – 1925) and Rosa (née Dimatto or De Santis) (?-?). He arrived in Canada during the early 1900s. It is not
	known to when he moved to the Powell River area but possibly about 1911 or 1912. He had a farm in the Townsite near Maple Avenue and Hawthorn Street. Siblings seem to have joined him at some point: his stepbrother, Giovanni (1880-1940) and his brothers George (1893-1944) and Michele (Mike) (1894-1962). In 1913, Guisseppe applied for a Crown Grant for District Lot 4726 in the Powell Lake area. He pre-empted it in 1914. By 1920 he had made the improvements and was granted a Certificate of Improvement. In 1922 he purchased the land for \$1. Guisseppe was granted a Certificate of Naturalization in Canada in March 1920. He farmed the land, built a home and sold produce to the citizens of Powell River.
