NOTES	The following is a description of Powell River Court Watch from the organization's perspective, retrieved from the Powell River Court Watch website in 2014. (defunct as at February 27, 2020).
	"Powell River Court Watch is a private non-profit organization which has implemented a much needed Court Watch Program in Powell River. The goal is to monitor and evaluate Powell River's criminal justice system from the public's point of view. We feel that our justice system needs more input from the community it serves.
	Many people think that court issues are secretive and hidden behind closed doors. CourtWatch brings information about our local judicial system to the public for review and scrutiny. Frankly, if we don't know what is happening there is nothing we can do about it. If we do know then we can react.
	It is hoped that by making people aware they will be able to react to problems and learn from other's mistakes. There is also the ability for the public to monitor the judicial process and insure the cases are handled in a timely, fair, but expeditious fashion.
	If one person is discouraged from committing an illegal offense because they know they may be subject to public scrutiny, the program is well worth the effort.
	Our hope is for a community that is safe today and for our children's future."
