Forestry, Fishing, & Fields! Oh my!

Grades 4-5

Topics: regional geology, natural resources, hunting.

Learning Goals: Students will increase familiarity with what museums do and how the qathet Museum & Archive serves the region. They will also become more familiar with the museum with a scavenger hunt.

Curriculum links: Grade 4 Social Studies, Grade 4 Science, Grade 5 Science

- Using maps to identify the location of natural resources in the qathet Region in relation to characteristics of physical geography
- how seasons and tides affect the use of resources, both living and non-living
- Identifying significant local natural resources
- Understanding the local geography and geology, and how that affects the qathet Region

What to expect:

Come to the museum ready for:

1. a hands-on group activity
2. a museum-wide activity
3. discussion and sharing

Come to the museum prepared with:

1. clothing and footwear appropriate for indoor activities
2. students pre-divided into four (4) teams
3. a quick snack for each student (optional)
4. money for the gift shop (optional)

Activities:

- a short classroom learning session
 - Students will attend a presentation about the natural resources available in the qathet Region
- a hands-on group activity
 - students will work together to correctly place natural resources on a map of the qathet Region
- a museum-wide team activity
 - students will be broken into teams and sent around the museum to solve and collect clues
- Additional, individual scavenger hunts will be made available

What you can expect as an educator:

- attend with your class
- recruit 2 additional adults for supervisory support
- receive a complementary booklet after your visit, with additional resources
