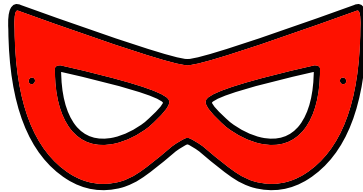
**July 19<sup>th</sup> - August 1<sup>st</sup> : Rock Hounds**

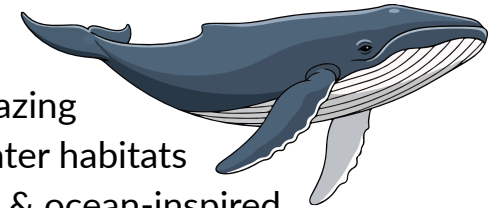
**July 5<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup> : Into the Woodlands**

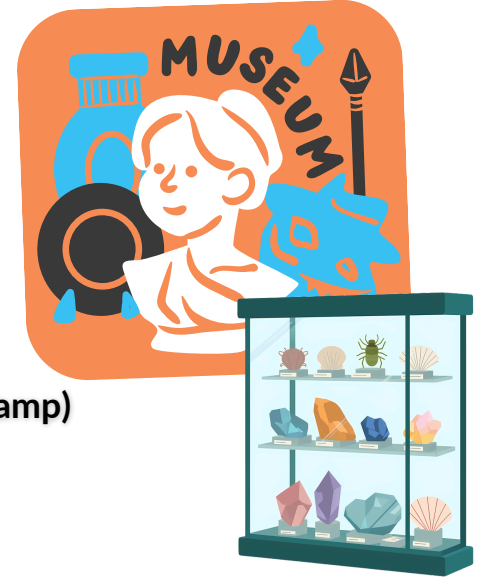

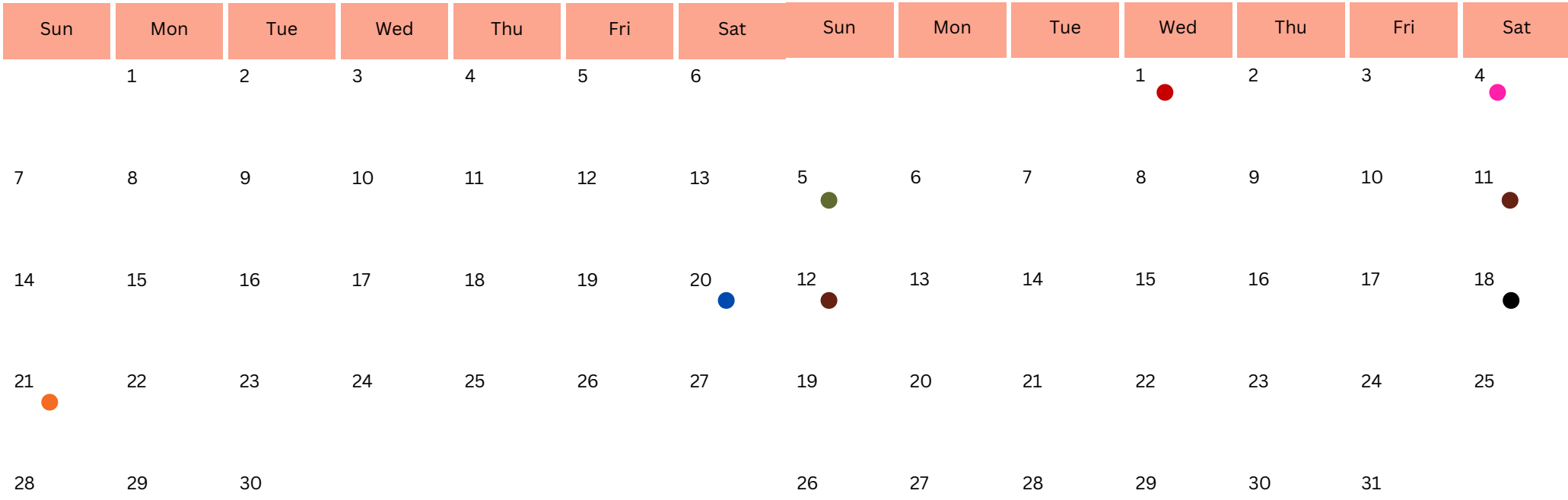

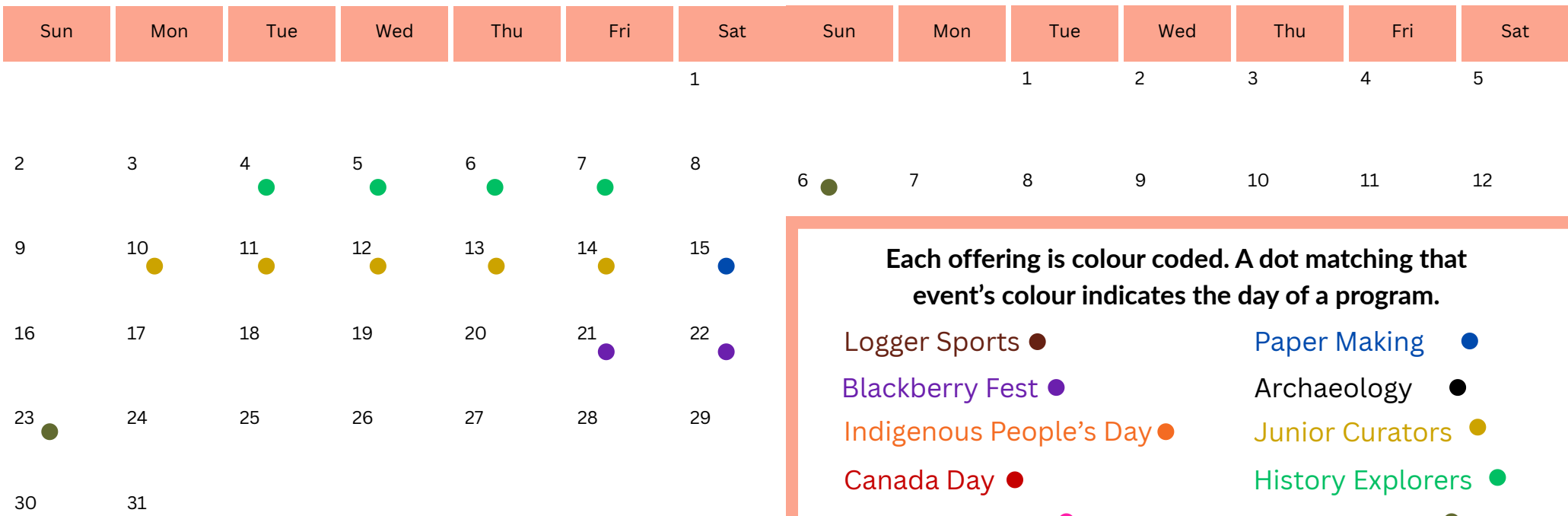
